



**Bee Branch Water Quality Initiative  
Septic Inspection and Repair Program 2023  
Terms and Conditions**

The following are the terms and conditions applicable to the program:

- The property owner must apply to WaterWays before any work is undertaken.
- If approved, WaterWays will contact a pre-approved contractor(s) to inspect and repair the septic system.
- The property owner will be expected to pay 40% of the cost of covered inspection and repairs.
- In its sole discretion, WaterWays may reduce the property owner's share based upon demonstrated financial need.
- Funds for the program are limited. Generally, priority will be given to the earliest applications and to those that are most likely to produce the largest positive impact on the water quality of Bee Branch. WaterWays reserves the right to determine the priority of those receiving grants, in its sole discretion.
- Only systems more than 10 years old and actively in use are eligible.
- To be eligible, property must be at one of the following addresses located in the Town of Signal Mountain, Hamilton County, Tennessee (Upper Bee Branch Watershed):
